Sealed proposals will be received by the Division of Public Works, State of Idaho, at 502 N. 4th St, Boise, ID until **2:00 pm**, local time, on **September 11, 2012** for DPW Project No. **11197 Renovation, Suites 162/139, Science Building, Boise State University, Boise, Idaho.**

A description of the work of this project can be summarized to include renovation of suite 162 on the first floor into an animal holding suite for mice, rats, and zebra fish. The suite requires new concrete floor, construction of hallway and five rooms for housing, storage, procedure, and ware wash. Suite 239 on the second floor will be for the housing of a variety of birds and requires demolition of the existing interior finishes and construction of new rooms including housing, isolation, and procedure/ware wash areas. Both suites require new mechanical, plumbing, and electrical systems. The project will be constructed in two phases under this one contract.

Proposals will be opened and publicly read at the above hour and date.
