Sealed proposals will be received by the Division of Public Works, State of Idaho, at Lewis Clark State College Facilities Office, 538 11th Avenue, Lewiston, Idaho Until **2:00 PM**, prevailing local time on **Wednesday, May 7, 2014** for **DPW Project No. 14160, Re-Roof Student Union Building, Lewis Clark State College, Lewiston, Idaho.**

A description of the work of this project can be summarized to include leaving the existing roof systems and installing a new roofing system over the top. Existing roofing systems consists of single-ply membrane systems and metal standing seam roofing. Standing Seam Metal Roofing is to remain intact and is not covered under this work (see plans for locations). **Bidders may choose to bid only one or both of the base bid proposals.** New roofing system will consist of one of the following:

Base Bid #1: The work consists of leaving the existing roof systems and installing a new roofing system over the top. Existing roofing systems consists of single-ply membrane systems and metal standing seam roofing. Standing Seam Metal Roofing is to remain intact and is not covered under this work (see plans for locations). New roofing system will consist primarily of Prefinished Sealed Seam Metal Roofing over metal hat channel framing system and insulation. Systems include miscellaneous framing, flashings, parapet caps, crickets, drains, etc. associated with the roof areas.

Base Bid #2: The work consists of removing portions of the existing roof systems (see Drawings) and installing a new roofing system over the top of the existing insulation. Existing roofing systems consists of single-ply membrane systems and metal standing seam roofing. Standing Seam Metal Roofing is to remain intact and is not covered under this work (see plans for locations). New roofing system will consist primarily of a Polyvinyl Chloride (PVC) Roofing System over vapor retarder and cover board. Systems include miscellaneous framing, flashings, parapet caps, crickets, drains, etc. associated with the roof areas.

Proposals will be opened and publicly read at the above hour and date.
