Sealed proposals will be received by the Division of Public Works, State of Idaho, at **Idaho State University Maintenance and Operations Office, 749 E. Humbolt, Pocatello, ID 83209** until **2:00 pm**, local time, on **Tuesday, June 3, 2014** for **DPW Project No. 14232 Replace Elevators and Fire Alarm System, Garrison Hall, Idaho State University, Pocatello, Idaho.**

A description of the work of this project can be summarized to include removing and replacing the existing elevators including all equipment and controls not being reused for new elevators, all structural work required for the replacement of the existing elevators, installing fire rated doors at elevator entrances to provide smoke proof shaft, upgrading the fire alarm system, upgrading electrical system as required to accommodate the new elevator, replacing doors in elevator lobby with 1 hour fire rated doors.
