A description of the work of this project can be summarized to include:

Demolish selected windows/frames and replace them with new. Some of the windows/frames will be demolished by an abatement contractor as asbestos has been found select locations (see drawings). The demolition of windows with asbestos present is not part of this projects scope. The contract will need to coordinate with the abatement contractor to ensure the demolished windows are properly sealed until the new window can be added.
