1. <u>Information Only:</u> A conceptual design study (attachment provided in the RFQ) for this project was previously completed for the purpose of establishing a baseline for new construction and a budget for the proposed facilities and is not meant to represent the final design. Prior involvement in the study does not preclude the Design Professional from participation in the selection process for this project.

### 2. <u>Responses to questions:</u>

Question #1: Are you seeking a specific population designation regarding the CARF Accreditation?

Answer #1: The new setting types will likely be accredited as a Behavioral Health Program. The department is reviewing specialty types currently including Crisis Program, Crisis Stabilization for AOS and Community Integration and Community Housing as possible options for Step Down. No final determinations have been made.

Question #2: What is the expected occupancy classification for the AOS Unit? Step-down?

Answer #2: The project is currently working with Licensing and Certification and Medicaid to determine the final occupancy classification. Classifications under review include institutional and residential. No final determinations have been made.

Answer #3: For these buildings they are referred to as residents.
