Question #1: *"Pursuit to Title 54, Chapter 3 of Idaho Code, the Design Professional shall specifically identify an individual Architect licensed in the State of Idaho who will supervise all architectural services contained in this request for Qualifications"*

I wish to clarify that any Licensed Design Professional in the State of Idaho can be identified whether that is Architect, Landscape Architect or Civil Engineer, can be identified to supervise the professional services. The majority of services described in this rfq will focus on civil engineering and landscape architecture.

Answer #1: The requirement stated specifically is related to the Architect on the team and that the architectural services will be supervised by that licensed architect. There is a separate requirement to list a Primary Point of Contact. This can be independent of any licensed professional. The Principal in Charge, that is part of Section D, can be any discipline, but all individuals will need to meet State of Idaho licensing requirements.
